Students usually arrive in September and do the full year. It is also possible to do one term, usually September to Christmas. We have places in both single sex and mixed schools at all levels as follows;

Age 12/13 First Year : most schools do a taster year where students study between 14 and 18 subjects

Age 13/14 Second Year : students study the core subjects [English, Irish, Maths, Religion, P.E.] and 6 others [Art, Sceince, Business, Home Economics etc.] that are selected by the student.

Age 14/15 Third Year : students continue with their second year subjects and do their first sate examination [Junior Certificate] in June.

Age 15/16 Transition Year : a year where the students study the core subjects but also study many subjects not covered in the Junior and Leaving Certificate examinations [computers, drama, film making etc.]

Age 16/17 Fifth Year students study the core subjects [English, Irish, Maths, Religion, P.E.] and a combination of 3/4 others [Art, Sceince, Business, Home Economics etc.] selected by the student.

Age 17/18 Sixth Year : students continue with their fifth year subjects and do their final sate examination [Leaving Certificate] in June.

Refunds Policy

1. If the student is unable to commence the course due to legitimate causes, such as bereavement [death of a close family member] or serious illness, a full refund of the deposit will be give minus an administration fee of €500.
2. If the student is unable to complete the programme for legitimate reasons, no refund of fees already paid will be made. Any fees due at that point must be paid in full. No further fees will be charged.

School Holidays

October mid-term break

One week - Usually end of October/beginning of November

Christmas

Schools usually close for two weeks from around December 21st or 22nd

February mid-term break

Schools close for one week in mid-February

Easter

Schools close for two weeks, usually one week either side of Easter Sunday

The students usually go home for Christmas and Easter and some go home for mid-term breaks. It is possible to stay in Ireland during the holidays. A weekly supplement applies.

Travelling to and from School : Regarding getting to and from school, in many cases, the families are close enough to the school for the student to walk. In some cases they live further than walking distance from the school. The students get to and from school in the same way as the host family children, sometimes by car with the parents, sometimes by school bus and sometimes by public transport. In the case of public transport, the journeys tend to be short, 15 to 30 minutes.
